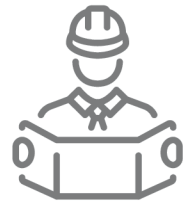


THE ENGINEERS PACKING STRATEGY - THE SUITCASE



RULES I FOLLOW WHEN PACKING MY **SUITCASE** FOR A HOLIDAY

1. PACK THE RIGHT AMOUNT OF CLOTHES

- COUNT THE NUMBER OF DAYS YOU ARE TRAVELLING
- DETERMINE HOW MANY DAYS BETWEEN LAUNDRY DAYS
- DIVIDE THE NUMBER OF TRAVEL DAYS BY NUMBER DAYS BETWEEN LAUNDRY DAYS
- ADD 1

2. BRING TWO PAIRS OF SHOES

AS AN EXTRA AND TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF UNIQUE OUTFITS YOU HAVE AVAILABLE

3. ROLL YOUR CLOTHES

PREVENTS WRINKLES AND LETS YOU FIT MORE IN YOUR SUITCASE

4. PACK HEAVY ITEMS CLOSE TO THE WHEELS

EASIER TO MOVE AROUND AND LESS LIKELY TO CRUSH OTHER ITEMS

5. KEEP TOILETRIES IN A ZIPLOCK BAG

BAG HANDLERS THROW BAG. THIS PREVENTS LIQUIDS FROM SPILLING OVER YOUR ITEMS.

6. PACK AN EXTRA COMPACT DUFFLE BAG

ADDITIONAL STORAGE FOR THE RETURN TRIP IF REQUIRED

7. PACK YOUR SHOES LAST

SLIP THEM INTO THE REMAINING GAPS TO SAVE SPACE

8. DON'T PACK IMPORTANT OR VALUABLE ITEMS

PUT THESE IN YOUR CARRY ON INSTEAD

9. DON'T OVERPACK

SAVE SPACE FOR SOUVENIERS AND NEW CLOTHES



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
